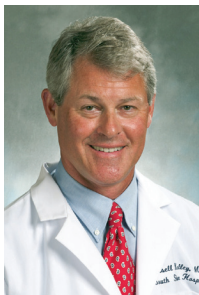


South Shore Hospital Now Offers 3D Breast Mammography Screening
